

PAINT MASKING TOLERANCES

A variety of masking techniques are used in powder coating for both functional and aesthetic reasons.

POPULAR MASKING TECHNIQUES:

- Tapes and Discs Adhesive, heat-resistant tape strips and discs can be applied before coating.
- Plugs and Caps Silicone cone-shaped plugs fill holes and caps cover studs before coating.
- Foil Wrap Large surfaces can be covered with a foil wrap before coating.
- Air and Vacuum Mask Before baking, a low pressure blast of air can remove powder, or a vacuum mask can leave a sharper break line.
